Lesson # 1 Lesson Scripture: 2 Sam. 1-4

Lesson Facts: (Main points to cover...)

- Man tells David, Saul & Johnathan are died (lies about it)
- David sad
- David prays and ask God what to do, then does it.
- Juda & Israel in war for many years
- lots of people die, but ungodly men take revenge - David punished these people for doing wrong

Principle: (Concept / Key truth to be gained...)

- Always tell the truth
- Always do what God wants
- Pray to God

Application: (How student can apply...)

- Sing: old & New Testament songs

Prayer: - go around table ask each child for one thing to pray to God about

- let one child say the prayer, use clip on name / prayer paper for whos turn

Review: who is king? Does the king follow God? when should we tell the truth?
Does King David pray (a little or always) The first time David goes to get the Ark
does he do it right? Does he do it right the second time?
Who was killed for touching the ark?

Lesson Facts: (Main points to cover...)

- King David lived in a nice house
- Ark in a tent • ~~David wanted to bring the Ark back~~ • Nathan didn't ask God!
- God talked to Nathan - Nathan told David • David prayed to God
- David went to war with several countrys • Defeated them all, because God was w/ him
- David started collecting materials so his son could build a house for God

Principle: (Concept / Key truth to be gained...)

- praise God
- Always pray to God and do His will!, Not what you want just because it seems good.

Application: (How student can apply...)

- pray always • do what the bible says always
- do what you can for the Lord when you can

Activities:

- color sheet, map sheet
- glue, cut, materials David was collecting

Lesson #: 1

Lesson Scripture: 2 Sam. 9-10

Obedience - knowing God promises reward & punishment

Visuals / Resources: • flash a cards, kids picture bible

Welcome Activity: - Attendance - sticker & song "Ella came to class"
- Sing old & new testament songs

Prayer: go around table, each child says one thing to pray for.
one child prays, use clip on name-prayer paper

Review:

- How did Saul really die? • When should we pray? • Who is King?
- When should we tell the truth? Tell me about going to get the Ark both times.
- Who was killed for touching Ark? What did David want to do for God? • Did Nathan ask God first?

Lesson Facts: (Main points to cover...)

- David wants to show kindness to Saul's family.
- David gets Jonathan's son, has him eat at his table
- David tried to be nice to the new king Hanun, because his dad died. Hanun didn't like it. They went to war and David won, because God was w/ him

Principle: (Concept / Key truth to be gained...)

- Always be nice to others, do the right thing even if others think you're ^{silly} weird for it!
- Do not assume the worst of people
- Look around and see who you can be a blessing to.

Application: (How student can apply...)

- say hi to strangers, help any you can, (open door) help your moms or dads

Lesson 9

Lesson title: Solomon builds a temple and his agreement to his lineage
Lesson Scripture: 1 Kings 5-9; 2 Chron 2-7

Visual/Resources

We have a sheet to show the temple that we will be showing the kids to give them a better perspective of the scale of the building

Welcome Activity: Color Sheet, Attendance sticker and song, song of the bible

Prayer: Move close pin down each class to give everyone a chance to say a prayer

Review: David had Solomon anointed as the next king after him and reminded him to rule as God commanded. David did pass away and Solomon reigned as king. God came to Solomon in a dream and told him he would grant him one wish and Solomon asked for Wisdom.

Lesson Facts:

1. One of the things Solomon does while king is builds a temple to the Lord. He returned the ark of the covenant in the temple
2. The took thousands of people to construct (by my calculation 183,600)
3. The temple was 90 ft long, 45 ft high, and 30 ft wide.
4. He asked God to dwell in the temple and God agreed as long as the people stayed faithful to God.

Principles:

God wants us to worship him, but he has giving us certain instructions on how to worship him. So, it is very important that we praise God the way he has commanded.

Application:

Name some things we do in church to worship God? (pray, study his word, those that are baptized take communion every first day of the week, teach others about God)

Activities:

1. Show them the picture of the temple
2. Temple Jigsaw puzzle (divide the room into two parts and see who can build the temple the fastest)
3. Decorate and assemble Solomon temple. Each kid gets a section of the building and colors and decorates and then we assemble it after everyone is done.

- Solomon decides to build a temple to the Lord and Solomon listens to every detail and follows everything that God tells him when it comes to building the temple
- God had very specific instructions on how tall, wide, and deep to make it. Solomon never went against what God told him when building this temple.
- After it was built they returned the ark of the covenant to the inside of the temple
- Solomon asked God to dwell in the temple and God agreed as long as Solomon and his people followed God's laws.
