We are looking forward to teaching your child this quarter, July - September. We will be studying the last part of the life of Christ with many of the lessons in the last week leading up to His crucifixion and resurrection. Linda will be teaching lessons 1-6, and Emily will be teaching lessons 7-13.

Linda will be using the following verses in the first half of the quarter:

Mark 12:30 - for lessons 1 - 2

"...Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength."

John 10:27 - for lessons 3 - 6

"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me."

John 11:25 - for lessons 4 - 6

"...The one who believes in Me will live, even if he dies"

Emily will be using the following verses in the second half of the quarter:

Matt 24:42 - for lessons 7-9

"Be alert, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming."

Mark 16:16 - for lessons 10-13

"Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned."

We ask that you pray for us as we teach because we understand the responsibility of teaching these young minds about our loving Savior. We hope we can be pleasing to God in every thing we do and teach.
